2. **Get their attention.** **V. 16**
3. **Know your audience.** **V. 16**
4. **Find common ground.** **V. 16-22**
5. **Introduce Jesus Christ and tell of His salvation.** **V. 23-26**

Study Questions on Acts 13

1. Where was the church that sent out Paul and Barnabas as missionaries? Acts 13:1-3
2. Is this a different Antioch (v.14) than mentioned earlier in Acts 13:1? Can you locate two different Antiochs on a map of that time near the Mediterranean Sea? Why were Paul & Barnabas there?
3. Where in the city did Paul and Barnabas go first to share the Gospel? Why did they go there first?
4. What did Paul have in common with those he was speaking to in the synagogue? Do you think Paul's audience agreed with what he said in the first part of his message? V.17-22
5. What evidence does Paul give that Jesus was the Messiah in verses 22-26? The Messiah (Christ) was supposed to be a descendant of what person? Who fulfilled that prophecy?
6. Who was the prophesied messenger who prepared the way for the Messiah? What did the messenger say about the greatness of Jesus Christ?
7. How had God sent His salvation to the Jews and also the Gentiles? V. 26
