TIME FOR SPIRITUAL TUNE-UP?

2 Cor. 13:5-11, Gen. 5:21-24, Col. 3:2-3, Ps. 46:10, Acts 6:4,
James 2:23, 1 John 4:19, Matt. 22:36-40, Rom. 8:29

1. We are to examine and test ourselves to see that we are in the faith and that Jesus Christ is in us (2 Cor. 13:5).
2. In Genesis chapter 5, Enoch simply “walked with God.” What does it mean to “walk with God?”
3. Paul tells us in Col. 3:2-3 to set our minds on things that are above, not on earth, for we have died and our lives are hidden with Christ in God.
4. In Psalm 46:10, the Psalmist instructs us to “be still and know that I am God.”
5. In Acts chapter 6, the disciples devote themselves to prayer and serving according to the Word.
6. We are called to cultivate our relationship with Christ, as Abraham did with God, “and the Scripture was fulfilled that says, ‘Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness’—and he was called a friend of God” (James 2:23).
7. Our capability to love is enabled because God first loved us (1 John 4:19).
8. In Matthew 22:36-40, Jesus describes the greatest commandments are to “love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind,” and to “love your neighbor as yourself.”
9. The more we know Christ, the more we love Him, serve Him, and become more like Him. Through this process, we are being “conformed to the image of his Son” (Romans 8:29).
