## WAYS TO FIND HELP

Acts 4:23-31

### SHARE YOUR PROBLEM. V.23

- There were threats and opposition against the preaching of the gospel. 4:13-22
- Peter and John presented their concern. They were afraid that the threats and the actions of the chief priests and elders might hinder the preaching of the gospel.

### PRAY ABOUT YOUR PROBLEM. V. 24-30

- They prayed about their concern. Prayer should be one of the first responses to a believer's problems.
- They recognized God's greatness and power while they prayed. No problem is too great for our almighty God to handle.
- They were reminded while praying that opposition against Christ was prophesied and to be expected.

### TRUST IN GOD FOR HELP. V. 31 Believe that God answers prayer.

- God shook the place after they had prayed.
- God let them know that He was responding to their prayers by a physical demonstration of His power.
- They were filled with the Holy Spirit. Through the power of the Holy Spirit they were able to preach the Word of God with boldness.
