The Power of Godly Friendship and Loyalty

- 1. Covenant Friendship is Rooted in Spiritual Connection Do you have people in your life who are knit to your soul? Are you building relationships based on God's purposes—or just convenience?
- 2. Godly (Covenant) Friendship Stands Strong in Times of Crisis Are you the kind of friend who stands with others in their valleys? Do you surround yourself with people who stand by you in times of need?
- 3. Covenant Friendship Involves Honest Conversation Do you allow space for honest conversations in your friendships? Can you speak truth in love—and receive it in return?
- 4. Covenant Friendship Requires Loyalty Over Convenience Are you the kind of friend who remains loyal even when it costs you something?
- 5. Covenant Friendship Makes Room for Emotion and Support Are you emotionally present in your friendships? Can you be honest about what you feel?
- 6. Covenant Friendship Leaves a Legacy The investment you make in godly friendships today can echo for generations.
- 7. Jesus: The Fulfillment of Covenant Friendship Jesus doesn't just call us servants—He calls us friends and invites us to walk in that same kind of friendship with others.

Study Questions:

- How did Jonathan treat David? Why might he have treated David like this? (1 Samuel 18:1-4)
- 2. How does the covenant between Jonathan and David reflect their faith and commitment to each other?
- 3. How does Jonathan show covenant faithfulness to David?
- 4. How does Jonathan balance his loyalty towards his father and his friendship with David? How can we apply this in situations where we have conflicting loyalties?
- 5. Jonathan puts his reputation on the line for David. Have you ever done this for a friend? For Christ? What was the outcome?
