WAYS TO GLORIFY THE LORD

Psalm 34:1-8

1. "BLESS THE LORD." v.1

"At all times." Keep His praise on your lips continually.

2. "BOAST IN THE LORD." v.2

It is good to tell people about how great the LORD is.

This is the kind of boasting that the humble are involved in and rejoice in.

3. MAGNIFY THE LORD. v.3

If you exalt the LORD, you lift him high by your words and praise so that others might see Him.

You magnify the LORD by helping others see His greatness. We should magnify the LORD together.

4. TRUST IN THE LORD. v.4-8

What happens to those who seek the LORD?

- They find answers to prayer. v.4, 6
- They are delivered from their fears. v.4
- Those who trust in the LORD are not ashamed or disappointed. v.5
- They are delivered from their troubles. v. 6, 7
- Those who seek and trust the LORD are blessed by Him. v.8

3. Can you over-do praising the Lord? Why? V. 2
4. Why should you boast in the Lord and not in yourself?

6. What benefit did David get from praying to the Lord? What benefits do you get from praying? V. 4
7. What good things has the Lord done for those who trust in Him? V. 4-7
8. What do those who trust in the Lord find out about Him? V. 8
9. What ways do you magnify the Lord? What other ways could you magnify the Lord?
