HOW TO HAVE A VICTORIOUS LIFE

Acts 16:11-24

1. RECIEVE THE TRUTH V. 11-15

Lydia was a religious woman who worshipped God.

She evidently had not heard that Jesus Christ had come and had died for her sins. Her heart was opened by the Lord to receive the truth. Lydia received Christ as her Savior. Have you received Christ?

2. LIVE A LIFE OF SERVICE V. 15

After believing on Jesus and being baptized, Lydia wanted to have Paul and his companions stay at her house. She also made her house available for believers to meet. V. 40

3. RESIST EVIL V. 16-18

By the power of Christ, Paul commanded a demon to leave a woman who had been disrupting their ministry. God's power is greater than any demon or evil person.

Study Questions on Acts 16:11-24

1. To what city of Europe did the missionaries go? V. 12
2. Where did the missionaries go on the Sabbath to evangelize and to whom did they speak? V. 13, 14
3. What wonderful things did God do in Lydia's life? V. 14, 15
4. What acts of service to God and man did Lydia do after her salvation?
5. What acts of service have you done since you have been saved? What do you plan to do to serve God and man in the future? Are you living a life of service?
6. How did Satan disrupt Paul's ministry? How did Paul deal with the spiritual opposition? V. 16-18
7. How is God's power shown to be greater than Satan's in this passage?
8. What did Paul and Silas endure because of casting out the demon from the woman? V. 19-24
9. How is God's power demonstrated in your life? In what ways are you resisting evil?
