God was with Joseph even when his brothers terribly mistreated him. v. 9

- How was the rejection of Joseph like the rejection of Jesus by Israel?
- Are you rejecting Jesus or have you received Him as your Savior?

God rescued Joseph out of all his troubles. v. 10

God exalted Joseph. v. 10

God especially watched over Joseph because he was a man of faith.

God enabled Joseph to save the lives of his brothers and father. v. 11, 12

God enabled Joseph to forgive his brothers and treat them well. v. 13

God's mercy to you is far greater than the mercy that Joseph showed to his brothers.

God enabled Joseph to take good care of his family. v. 14
