WAYS TO SHARE THE WORK OF THE LORD

Acts 6:1-7

PROBLEM SOLVE: Deal with ministry problems. v. 1

In this case, the need for ministry was noticed because of complaints.

In church ministries, there are physical needs that must be attended to as well as the spiritual needs.

PRIORITIZE: Make sure the Word and prayer are not neglected. v. 2

The twelve Apostles had been called primarily to the ministry of the Word of God and prayer. The Apostles were not above serving food; they just could not devote themselves to the food ministry. They couldn't do all of the ministry that needed to be done.

DELEGATE: Choose others to serve. Share the ministry. v. 3

FOCUS: Focus on the ministries that God has called you to do. v. 4

CHOOSE WISELY: Choose people who have a godly testimony. v. 5

Those who are chosen for a ministry should be people with high spiritual qualifications. You should live for the Lord while you serve the Lord.

PRAY: Pray for those who are called to serve. v. 6

WATCH: Watch God work. God will bring positive results and bless our efforts as we share the work of the Lord. v. 7

Because the Word of God was not neglected, more people kept hearing the Word. The number of the disciples increased rapidly.
