Contrasts between King Herod and KING JESUS

Matthew 2:1-23

Herod was self-centered and wanted to stay king at all costs. **JESUS CAME FOR YOUR BENEFIT.**

Herod was troubled by Christ's coming. V. 3 JESUS CAME TO RELIEVE YOUR TROUBLED HEART.

For those without faith, news about Jesus may be troubling. The Good News about Jesus is received as good news by those who accept it by faith. The wise men rejoiced at the arrival of Christ.

Herod acted in rebellion against God. JESUS DID THE WILL OF THE FATHER.

Jesus Christ gave His life that rebels could become God's children.

There is a place in Heaven for the "Herods" of this world who turn from their rebellion and turn to Jesus for forgiveness and salvation. The grace of God is so great that repentant "Herods" and sinners like you can go to heaven.

Herod was deceitful. He lied to the wise men. V. 7, 8 JESUS IS THE TRUTH.

Herod was full of anger and hate. V. 16 JESUS IS FULL OF LOVE FOR YOU.

Herod brought death. V. 13-18 JESUS BROUGHT ETERNAL LIFE.

Herod was a murderer. In his attempt to kill Jesus, he slaughtered a great number of boy babies and small boys.

Herod died without God. V. 19-20 JESUS DIED THAT YOU MIGHT BE WITH HIM FOREVER.
