

A History of White Marsh Church:

1792—White Marsh Methodist Episcopal Church was founded. The first building was thought to be of logs harvested on site.

1848—the existing brick church building was built.

2002 — The White Marsh United Methodist congregation was decommissioned and the church building was closed and began to fall into disrepair.

2010—the building and the cemetery were turned over to Historic White Marsh Church, Inc., a non-profit corporation, with Rev. James Salmon as chairman of the Board of Directors, and special services were held about 10 times that year.

2011—Bobby Allison was elected Board Chairman, and weekly Bible Study & prayer meetings were started, led by Rev. Jack Bailey.

2012— Rev. Winfield Talley, a retired Wesleyan Minister, became chairman of the board. During the summer of 2013 the Bible Study & prayer meetings and special services led to a three day revival, closing with a homecoming service and dinner on the grounds.

2014—The board then decided to start regular Sunday Morning services in January, calling Rev. Wesley Hall to serve as Pastor. Under his leadership, Biblical preaching, and with the cooperation of the Board, the building has been completely restored to its original beautiful condition, with an active congregation holding weekly worship services, prayer meetings, and Bible Studies along with the special meetings.

Beautiful, Historic White Marsh Church ... restored!



The Lamps, once filled with oil and lit during evening services, have been converted to electricity and continue to provide a warm light for services today. They are located along both galleries from the front to the rear of the church and are reminiscent of a past era.



In the center of this ceiling medallion, a large hook once suspended a counter-weighted oil lamp chandelier that could be lowered with a pull bar. The lamps were lighted, and the chandelier returned to about 8 feet above the church floor. The chandelier has been lost over the years, and may never be recovered.

The Pulpit and Altar

The Pulpit area is the original one installed when the church building was erected in 1848. It has remained basically unchanged, even to the seats and lectern. The altar and gallery rail decorative inserts are of cast iron.



Miraculously, God has also restored a living, breathing congregation to a once abandoned building.



A New Handicap ramp was installed to make accessibility part of our restoration process.

An Induction Loop has been installed for the hearing impaired.
