WHAT SHOULD CHRIST'S COMING CAUSE YOU TO DO?

Luke 2:8-20

1. IT SHOULD CAUSE YOU TO BE JOYOUS.

The joyous event of Jesus' Birth was proclaimed to the shepherds by an angel. v. 8-12

The joyous news was for all men, even the shepherds who lived in the fields with their flocks. v.8

God wanted everyone to know the good news of Christ's coming.

The angel told the shepherds who Christ was and where to find Him. v.11, 12

The shepherds received word the very day of Christ's birth.

Jesus was born in Bethlehem, the city of David. (This is where Christ had to be born. Micah 5:2).

He is (1) The Savior (2) The Christ (3) The Lord

The shepherds were given a sign so that they could recognize Christ when they went to Bethlehem.

2. IT SHOULD CAUSE YOU TO PRAISE GOD.

The birth of Jesus caused a multitude of the heavenly host to give glory to God. v. 13, 14

The coming of Christ caused the shepherds to praise God. v. 20

3. IT SHOULD CAUSE YOU TO SEEK THE SAVIOR

The birth of Christ caused the Shepherds to seek their Savior. v. 15, 16

The fact that the angels appeared to the shepherds is a strong indication that the shepherds were men of faith. They had probably been waiting for the Messiah to come in fulfillment of God's Word. Isa. 9:6. 7

The shepherds showed their faith by hurrying to Bethlehem to see their Savior. Have you found the Savior's salvation? If you have found the Savior, are you seeking to know Him better?

4. IT SHOULD CAUSE YOU TO TELL OTHERS THE GOOD NEWS.

The birth of Jesus caused the Shepherds to tell others the good news. The Shepherds were great witnesses. They told many people about Christ's birth. Are you following the shepherd's example? v. 17, 18
