Choose This Day

Joshua 24

1. Faith remembers God's faithfulness.

God never asks for our devotion apart from His grace. He first reminds us of His faithfulness. When we remember where God has brought us from, trusting Him with tomorrow becomes much easier.

2. Faith chooses whom it will serve.

Everyone of us must respond personally to God's invitation. Faith is continually surrendering our lives to the Lord who has already given Himself for us.

3. A faithful life becomes a lasting legacy.

One of the greatest legacies we can leave is a life that quietly points others to Jesus.

4. Jesus is the faithful One who enables our faithfulness.

The Christian life has never been about trying harder. It has always been about trusting more deeply in the One who is perfectly faithful.

5. Practical Applications:

- Remember God's faithfulness.
- Choose to serve the Lord today.
- Live a life that others can see.
- Keep your eyes on Jesus.

Personal Questions to Ponder This Week:

- Where has God shown His faithfulness in my life?*
- What daily choice is He asking me to make today?*
- How can my life point someone else to Christ this week?*
- What legacy of faith am I leaving for those who follow behind me?*

Discussion Questions for Bible Study:

- Why is remembering God's faithfulness such an important foundation for faithful living? What blessings or answered prayers stand out as you look back over your own life?
- Joshua declared, "**As for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.**" What do those words mean for you personally?
- What is one practical way you can choose to serve the Lord this week?
- How can our church family encourage one another to continue moving forward in faith?
