Study Questions on "A Father's Love"

3. How did the older son view his father's welcoming his younger brother back?

5. What does 1 John 4:7-21 teach us about God's love?

6. In the parable of the prodigal son, how does the father's love for his younger son reflect our heavenly father's love for us?
7. We can all learn from our life experiences and the choices we make. Can you identify and share an example of this in your life?
