HOW TO HONOR JESUS CHRIST

The Example of the Woman who Anointed Jesus Matthew 26:6-13
(Parallel Passages: Mark 14:3-9 & John 12:1-8)

HONOR JESUS BY GIVING.

The woman honored Him with a gift and worship. Matthew 26:6-7

1. What does the Scripture say about the perfume?
2. What did the woman do with the perfume?
3. Was Jesus worthy of such treatment?

When you give to Jesus, do it as an act of worship.

FOCUS ON THE VALUE OF JESUS.

His value was not overlooked by the woman but was overlooked by others. v. 8-9

1. How did some of the disciples feel about what the woman did?
2. How did some of the disciples think that the perfume could have been put to better use than anointing Jesus? v. 8
3. How much of a problem do you have with drawing wrong conclusions concerning the good deeds of others?

It is sad to see that some of the disciples felt that the perfume had been wasted. They certainly drew the wrong conclusion.

DO WHAT PLEASES JESUS.

Jesus commended the woman. v.10-13

1. How did Jesus defend the woman's actions? v. 10
2. What did Christ say that helped the disciples to see His value? v. 11
3. What other things does Christ say that showed the significance of what the woman had done? v. 12-13

It is good to know that Jesus Christ understands the actions and heart attitudes of those who serve him. The Lord never misunderstands the things that we do for Him. We must remember that our service to Jesus Christ is not for the approval of men but for the approval of God.
