A Legacy of Worship

- 1. David's Heart Worships Through Repentance (Psalm 51) Worship Begins in Honesty and Flows from a Broken Spirit. A legacy of worship begins with brokenness. God meets us in our failures, and it's often there—at our lowest—where the deepest worship is born.
- A Heart That Worships in Obedience and Sacrifice (2 Samuel 24)

 Worship Must Cost Us Something and Be a Response to God's Mercy.
 To build a legacy of worship, we must give God our best—not what's convenient, but what is costly to us.
- 3. A Heart That Worships with Trust (Psalm 23) Worship Is Rooted in Relationship, Persists Through the Valley, and Declares the Goodness of God. True worshipers don't just sing on the mountaintop—they walk with God in the shadows and the valleys of death, knowing His rod and staff are always near and available.
- 4. What Made David a Worshiper?- He didn't hide when he sinned—he repented. He didn't harden when he was corrected—he humbled himself. He didn't worship for show—he worshiped from the soul, from his heart.
- Our Legacy of Worship Worship is not limited to Sunday services—it's how you live, how you repent, how you trust, and how you sacrifice. Let your life sing the song of Psalm 23. Let your heart echo the cry of Psalm 51. And let your choices reflect the sacrifice of 2 Samuel 24.

Study Questions:

- 1. How does David's decision to conduct a census reflect upon his dependence on God? How can this be related to modern-day situations of trusting in human strength versus God's strength? (2 Sam. 24)
- 2. In what ways does 2 Sam. 24 challenge your understanding of obedience and trust in God?
- 3. How does Psalm 51 challenge your understanding of God's mercy and grace?
- 4. How can you apply the lessons of Psalm 23 to your daily life?
