Evidence of Christ's Resurrection

Matthew 27:57-28:18

- 1. Death could not hold Him. Mt. 27:57-61
- **2. Men could not keep Jesus in the tomb.** Mt. 27:62-28:4 The chief priests, Pharisees, Pilate, and the Roman soldiers did what they could to keep the body of Christ in the tomb. It was a small army of the world's best soldiers that guarded the tomb.
- 3. An angel proclaimed His resurrection. Mt. 28:5-7
- 4. Two women saw the empty tomb, heard the angel's message, and saw the resurrected Lord Jesus. Mt. 28:8-10
- 5. Unbelieving men could not destroy the evidence of His resurrection. Mt. 28:11-15

Because ungodly men could not keep Christ in the tomb, they lied about his resurrection. Lies cannot destroy the truth and evidence of the resurrection of Christ.

6. Many saw Jesus Christ after His resurrection. Mt. 28:16-18
