In what ways did Abraham show his faith in verses 1-8?

See also Isaiah 41:8 and James 2:24

Abraham was saved by the grace of God through faith.

"For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness." **Romans 4:3**

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9. Not of works, lest any man should boast." **Ephesians 2:8, 9**

What do you have in common with Abraham?

3. God directed the life of Abraham. V. 3, 4

- The fact that Abraham did what God said showed that Abraham fully benefited from the grace of God.
- Unlike many of his descendants, Abraham was obedient to God. V. 3, 4

4. God made and kept his promises to Abraham. V. 5-8
