**God Did Not Walk Away** - Psalm 104 reminds us that God did not simply create the world and step back. The same God who formed creation continues to sustain it. Every breath, every sunrise, every provision is held in His faithful care.

**Creation Lives in Dependence** - Creation trusts God for provision "in due season." We are invited to release anxiety and trust Him for today. (Psalm 104:27)

**Mercy Has No Expiration Date** - If you woke up this morning, mercy met you. "The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." (Lamentations 3:22-23)

**Living in Sustaining Grace** - Because God sustains us:

- We release the illusion of control.
- We practice daily gratitude.
- We rest without guilt.
- We trust God for today's provision.

**You are not holding your life together alone.** - The God who renews the earth and feeds the birds is faithfully sustaining you — right now.

### **Discussion Questions:**

1. Where in your daily routine might you be overlooking "ordinary mercies" that reflect God's sustaining love?
2. What is one area of your life where you are tempted to carry control rather than live in expectant dependence on God?
3. How does remembering that God's mercies are "new every morning" reshape the way you face regret, fear, or uncertainty?
4. What practical step could you take this week to live more consciously in trust — through gratitude, rest, or releasing anxiety?
