How the Grace of Christ is Revealed

(Saul: from Persecutor to Preacher)

Acts 9:1-22

1. **Believers have the victory and not their adversaries. V. 1-2 & Romans 8:26-39**
2. **The most unlikely people come to know Jesus Christ as savior. V. 1-2**
3. **The Lord reaches out to the lost. V. 3-6**
Christ forgives His enemies and makes them His friends.
4. **The Lord allows suffering to bring people to Himself. V. 7-9**
5. **The Lord uses other believers to minister to you. The Lord uses you to minister to other believers. V. 10-17**
6. **The Lord can turn a person's life around 180 degrees. V. 18-22**
7. **The Lord gives strength and ability for ministry. V. 22**
