James 1:5-8

1. WHAT IS WISDOM?

2. DO YOU LACK WISDOM?

Trials show us our inadequacies and the need for wisdom from God. Many situations show us our lack of wisdom.

Growing in wisdom also helps you grow in spiritual maturity.

What are some areas that you may be lacking in wisdom?

- **Decision making:** Joshua (Joshua 9); The Disciples (Acts 1:20-26)
- **Parenting:** Eli (1 Sam. 2:12-36)
- **Leadership:** Solomon (1 Kings 3:7-13)
- **Understanding God's Word:** Daniel 9; 1 Cor. 2:10-16; John 14:26; 1 John 2:27
- **Abilities and Skills:** Bezaleel (Exodus 31:1-6)

3. WHERE CAN YOU GET WISDOM?

- From God – "Let him ask of God"
- From God's Word

4. DOES ASKING FOR WISDOM REALLY WORK?

God "gives to all men liberally."

- An example of a man who asked God for wisdom: Solomon (1 Kings 3:7-13)
- But if you ask without having faith, God may not answer.

5. HOW SHOULD YOU ASK FOR WISDOM?

Ask with a confident faith.
