Hope – Waiting When God Seems Silent

The Art of Waiting, and Why We Aren’t Always Good at It
God does some of His greatest work in seasons of silence and waiting.

Waiting, a Common Theme in Isaiah and Luke
God is always working, even when He appears to be silent.

God’s Lessons in Hope

- #1: Silence is not the same as no
- #2: Your delays may be preparing a larger story
- #3: Obedience in waiting
- #4: God’s timing is always perfect
- #5: Hope lives in God’s promises, not our emotions

What Are Some Practical Applications for our Advent Hope?

- We are to keep praying—even when we don’t feel heard.
- We are to keep serving because hope grows through faithfulness.
- We are to keep listening, as silence prepares the soul for greater things.
- We are to keep trusting God, as His delays are not denials.
- We are to keep looking ahead because the promised light is coming.

Our Hope Holds in the Silence

- ~ If you feel in darkness, your hope says light is coming.
- ~ If you feel weary, your hope says God is near.
- ~ If you feel lost, your hope says Jesus is your way.
- ~ If you feel forgotten, your hope says God is faithful.
- ~ If you feel anxious, your hope says the Prince of Peace reigns.

Discussion Questions:

1. What is the difference between “optimism” and biblical hope?
2. Why do you think God often begins His work in “dark” or difficult seasons?
3. How have you seen God’s faithfulness in the past, and how does that strengthen your hope now?
4. What practical step can you take this week to make space for hope in your daily life?
