1. THE WRITTEN WITNESS 1 Cor. 15:3, 4

The written witness of the death of Christ 1 Cor. 15:3

Isaiah 53 prophesied the death of Christ and what it would accomplish.

The written witness of Christ's resurrection 1 Cor. 15:4

Prophecies of Isaiah 53:9; Psalm 16:10

Isaiah 53:10-12 Indicated a ministry following His death
New Testament Prophecies by Christ - Matthew 12:40; 16:21

2. THE EYEWITNESSES 1 Cor. 15:5-8

Many who doubted came to believe. Many saw Jesus Christ alive during the forty days after His death.

Have you put your faith in Jesus Christ for salvation? If not, ask the Lord to give you forgiveness of your sin and eternal life, right now?

7. Do you believe that Jesus died for your sins and arose again from the dead?
