#### ARE YOU AWAKE TO THE WORD?

A Midnight Message V. 7

Paul preached until midnight and beyond and he still had an audience. Imagine being so hungry to hear the Word of God that you would do that. When a person is hungry for the Word, they are more apt to enjoy long meals.

#### ARE YOU AWAKE SPIRITUALLY?

#### A Deadly Drowsiness V. 8, 9

Eutychus couldn't stay awake while Paul was preaching. He fell asleep and fell out of a third story window to his death.

Some people are spiritually asleep in church services: This is far more serious! "Wherefore he says, Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light." Ephesians 5:14

#### A Remarkable Resurrection V. 9-12
