SOME BENEFITS OF RESPONDING TO GOD'S WORD

James 1:19-21

1. GOD'S WORD WILL HELP YOU HAVE CONTROL. V. 19, 20

Many people are slow to listen, quick to speak, and quick to get angry. The Word helps you to submit yourself to God's control.

Remember that, most of the time, when you act in anger you are not going to act in a way that brings glory to God.

Verses that can help you avoid sinful anger:

Psalms 37:8 Cease from anger and forsake wrath: fret not yourself in any wise to do evil.

Proverbs 14:17 He that is soon angry deals foolishly:

Proverbs 14:29 He that is slow to wrath is of great understanding: but he that is hasty of spirit exalts folly.

Proverbs 15:1; 15:18; 16:32; 19:11; 29:22; Eccl. 7:9; Titus 1:7

2. GOD'S WORD WILL HELP YOU TURN FROM SIN. V. 21

With the challenge of the Word of God and the help of God, you can put aside your sinful practices. In place of wickedness, which was so much a part of your life, you are to allow God's Word to be engrafted into your life like a branch that is grafted into a tree.

3. GOD'S WORD WILL LEAD YOU TO SALVATION. V. 21

It is God's Word that reveals what Christ has done for you. It is the Word that the Holy Spirit uses to bring you to faith in Jesus Christ for salvation. Rom. 10:17 If you haven't, will you accept Jesus Christ as your Savior today?
