#### IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT GOD

Acts 17:16-34

## 1. God created the world and everything in it. v. 24

No man made God. Idols are manufactured by man. God is greater than any idol.

### 2. God does not need a temple to live in. v. 24

God is not contained in or confined to some temple like idols are.

### 3. God is the self-sufficient creator. v. 25

God does not have to have anything from man to keep Him going. Man is dependent on God; God is not dependent on man. He is not housed or fed by man like an idol.

#### 4. God made mankind from one man. v. 26

All people are related through Adam who was the first man that God created. Jesus Christ died for all mankind: He died for you!

- 5. God is sovereign over the nations. v. 26
- 6. God wants to have a personal relationship with you. v. 27
- 7. God is your creator and sustainer. v. 28
- 8. God is not like a manmade idol. He is our maker. v. 29
- 9. God wants all men to repent and turn to him. v. 30
- 10. God will judge through the resurrected Christ. v. 31
