HOW WAS THE ONLY INNOCENT MAN TREATED?

Matthew 26:57-68

Jesus was sinless: 2 Cor. 5:21; 1 John 3:5; 1 Peter 1:18-19 & 2:22; Heb. 4:15 & 7:26; Isa. 53:9

THEY TRIED TO FRAME THE INNOCENT ONE. v.57-62

The ones that tried to trump up charges against Jesus were those who were spiritual and political leaders of Israel.

1. Who was the spectator disciple who watched the trial? v. 58
2. What were the chief priest and the council trying to obtain in the trial? v. 59
3. Why did they want to obtain false testimony against Jesus? v. 59
4. What was false about the testimony of the last two witnesses? v. 61 (Read Jn. 2:13-22)
5. Why do you think Jesus remained silent after the false testimony? v. 62, 63; Isaiah 53:7

THEY ACCUSED JESUS OF BLASPHEMY. He spoke truth. v.63-66

1. Jesus was asked by the high priest if He was the Messiah, the Son of God. What was Jesus' answer? v. 63-64
2. What did they say that Jesus was worthy of?
3. What was the penalty for blasphemy according to the Old Testament Scriptures? Lev. 24:16

THEY ABUSED THE HOLY ONE. Jesus deserved worship. v. 67, 68

1. How was Jesus cruelly abused by those who condemned Him?
2. How do you treat Jesus Christ?
