## Blessed Are Those Who Are Persecuted for Righteousness' Sake

### The Eighth Beatitude:

"Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake... Blessed are you..."

Jesus promises blessing *not despite* persecution but *through* it.

### Persecution Defined:

Not minor discomforts or disagreements, but hostility, rejection, or false accusations **because of Christ** (Matt. 5:10–11; 1 Peter 4:14).

### Example of Pilgrims:

The Pilgrims were persecuted for obeying Scripture, sought freedom to worship, and gave the first Thanksgiving out of hardship—not abundance.

### Biblical Foundation:

Believers throughout Scripture faced persecution but found God faithful (Dan. 3; Ps. 34:1; 2 Tim. 3:12).

### Blessings in Persecution:

You stand in the line of the prophets.

You share in Christ's sufferings.

God's presence is nearest in the fire.

Heaven is your reward (Matt. 5:12).

### True Thanksgiving:

Gratitude is rooted not in comfort but in God's character and presence (1 Thess. 5:18).

### Applications for Today:

When you are persecuted for righteousness' sake, stand firm with grace. Cultivate gratitude in hardship, pray for the persecuted church, and teach the next generation the true heritage of Thanksgiving.

### Questions to Ponder:

1. What stands out to you about Jesus' final Beatitude in Matthew 5:10–12?
2. How does the story of the Pilgrims deepen your understanding of Thanksgiving?
3. What practical steps can we take to cultivate gratitude even when life is difficult?
4. How can you honor the legacy of thankful perseverance this Thanksgiving?
