Love: God's Gift That Changes Hearts

John 3:16-17, 1 John 4:7-12

The Love God Reveals — "For God So Loved The World"

This is the foundation of Advent love: It is love planned by the Father, revealed in the Son, poured out through the Spirit.

The Love God Gives — Transforming, Not Just Touching

- This love is initiating, as God loved us first. (1 John 4:10)
- This love is sacrificial.
- This love is personal. (Luke 1:25)
- This love is transforming.

The Love God Calls Us to Live — "If God So Loved Us..."

- Love must be visible. (1 John 3:18)
- Love must be sacrificial.
- Love must be patient and kind. (1 Corinthians 13:4)
- Love must flow toward the unlovely. (Matthew 5:44)

Practical Applications — How To Live Advent Love

- Ask God to soften your heart.
- Practice one act of sacrificial love each day
- Forgive quickly and fully.
- See people as God sees them.
- Let love lead to worship. (Luke 1:46)

Questions to Ponder:

1. Why is it important to remember that God loved us first?
2. How does the incarnation of God demonstrate His love?
3. What relationships in your life need the love of Christ this season?
4. How can you practice sacrificial love like Joseph this week?
